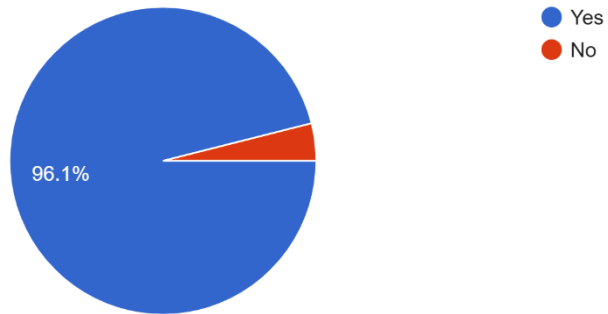


Does your child feel successful in their math class?

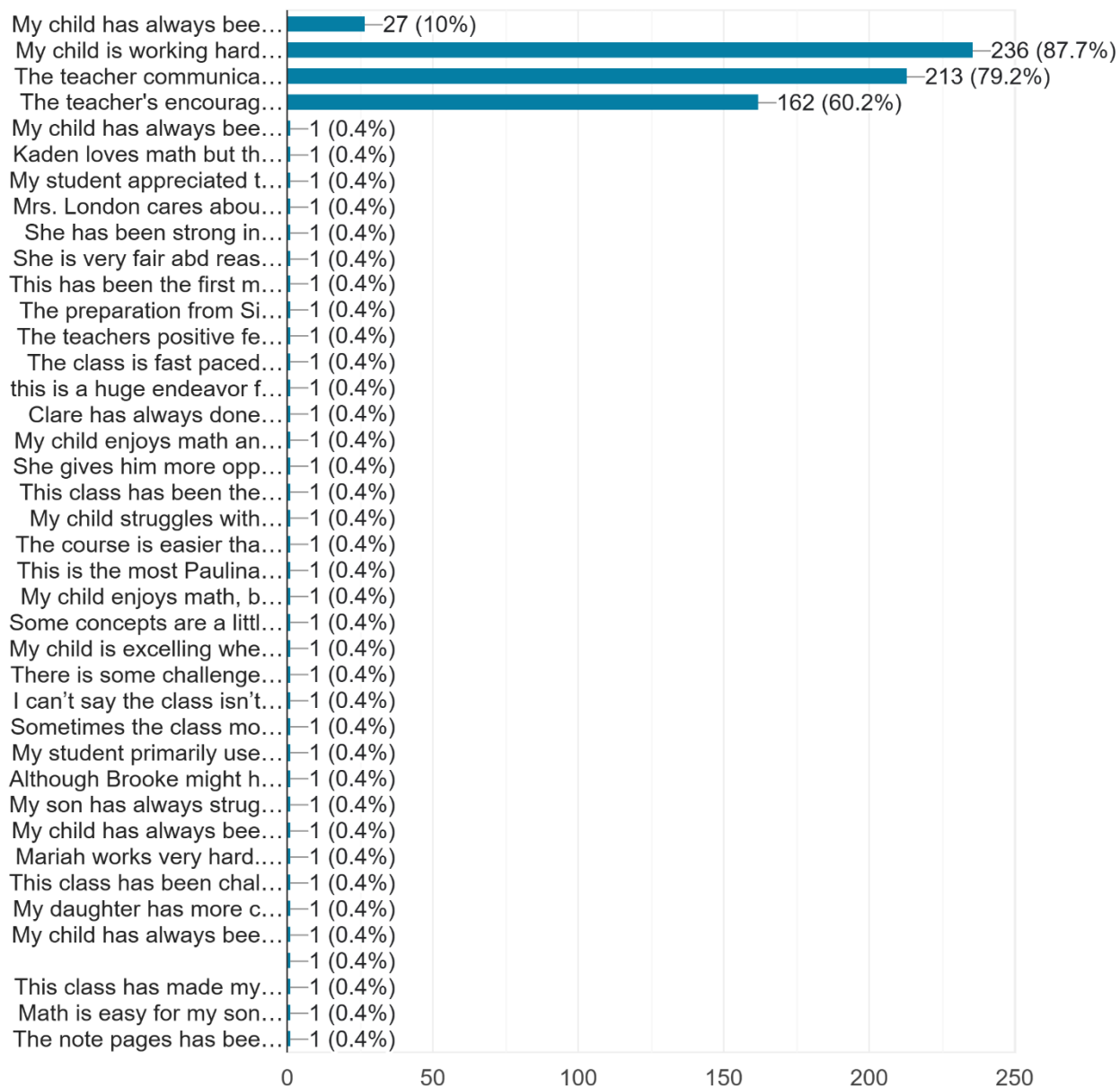
## My child feels successful in their math class

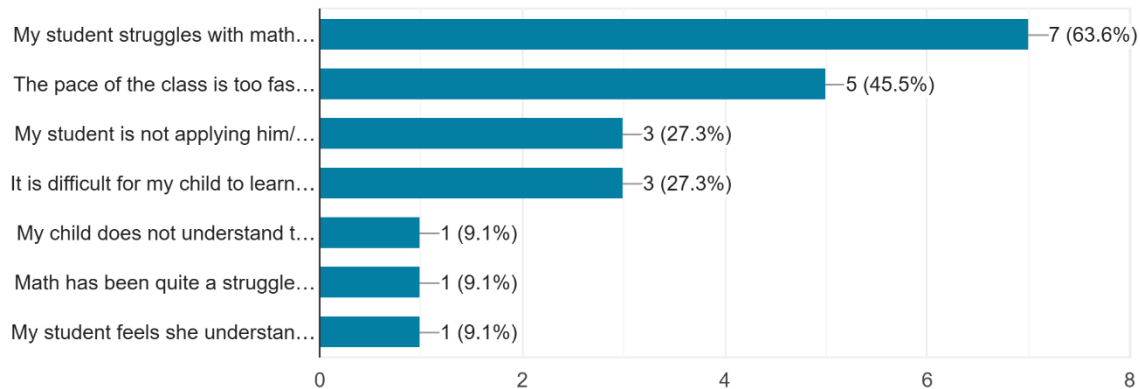
## My child is not feeling successful in math class
