Annual tuition is as follows:

- Pre-Pre-Algebra and Pre-Algebra: Tuition is \$600 (\$300 each semester)
- Algebra 1 (on-level and honors), Consumer Math, Geometry (on-level and honors), Algebra 2 (on-level and honors): Tuition is \$650 (\$325 each semester)
- Statistics, Pre-Calculus (on-level and honors), Calculus I (on-level and honors), Honors Calculus II: Tuition is \$700 (\$350 each semester)
- AP Calculus AB: Tuition is \$780 (\$390 each semester)
