



Excerpt from a Student Recommendation letter, demonstrating this student's success on standardized tests after participating in HSML courses:

During the spring of 2024, Jonathan received a perfect score on the math portion of the California State Test, the CAASPP Exam. Since High School Math Live's classes have students from all over the USA, we do not include test preparation or practice for any of the state exams. Jonathan's perfect score further demonstrates that he fully synthesizes and comprehends concepts taught in class. His capacity to apply that knowledge to an exam that was not specifically aligned with our coursework exhibits his expertise at identifying and solving problems in a variety of formats.

Additionally, in the fall of 2023, Jonathan informed me of his plan to take the AP® Pre-Calculus test in May 2024. The honors course that I teach is rigorous, but it is not aligned with the content of that exam, nor do we discuss the specific formatting of answers that the test graders require. Jonathan completed the coursework for our class and studied for the AP exam on his own. The result of his effort was a score of 5 out of 5 on that exam. This is more evidence of his ability to learn, synthesize, and apply knowledge in a variety of environments. Additionally, it emphasizes his self-discipline and attention to detail that propelled him to independently work toward the development of the skills required to meet the particular demands of that exam.
