As mentioned before three 50 minute classes or three one hour classes might be more helpful to break the material down in more efficient manner, and would help attention challenged students be able to focus better. Also having to have the quiz completed by Friday at 11 a.m. Pacific Time ( 1 p.m.) central time, is difficult for the struggling learning student. The weeks of the chapter tests, the time due is Sunday afternoon. This extra time is very helpful.

Based on my experience so far, I can't think of anything that needs to be improved.

I think 1.5 hours per class online is a bit long for my students... if possible, reducing to 1.25 hours for an online class would be easier on attention span.

I think a twice or three time weekly study hall with a teacher present for questions would be amazing.

I think it is effective and we have not had any issues.

I think you are accomplishing your goal!

I would like for the kids to receive stories about the History of Math, more about the Qualitative part of Math, not only the Quantitative, that kids get to learn about Pittagoras, Euclides, etc. I would like for you to offer a class on Classical Math or Liberal Arts Math, or History of Math (could just be a short AMP 4 or 8 or 12 prerecorded clases), that you would include ideas from reality and art, and arquitecture like shown in Constructing the Universe Series, where the kids get to see Math in real life, in architecture and in Nature.

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Is there a reason that High School Math Live does not take the spring break closer to Easter? Most schools in CA take their Spring Break around Easter. I know there is no way to have everyone's schedules line up, but every year it is a challenge for me to figure out how to give my kids a spring break when the weeks off are far apart.

It would be nice if the students could have a non-recorded portion of class to verbally ask questions and review homework instead of just using the chat feature.
